ApHC 2015 ELECTION NOTICE

MOSCOW, Idaho – The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) announces the following candidates who submitted Declarations of Candidacy for the 2015 ApHC Board of Directors election:

Territory I, Zone B:

Terms for new directors will begin January 2016. According to Article IV, Section 2 of the ApHC Bylaws, “If only one (1) member is properly nominated for election as director from a geographical zone, that nominee shall be deemed elected as director without conducting the election. In the event there is no member properly nominated for election as a director from a geographical zone, the ApHC Board of Directors shall appoint a qualified ApHC member to any such director position for the full term of three (3) years.”

Due to these circumstances, the only vote that will take place in October is a bylaw change proposal to reduce the size of the ApHC Board of Directors from nineteen (19) to thirteen (13). Current members in good standing as of August 31, 2015 will be eligible to vote in this year’s election. The election will begin at 8:00 am Pacific Time on October 1, 2015 and end at 5:00 pm Pacific Time on October 31, 2015. Post cards will be sent to eligible members with their voting information.

The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) was established in 1938 with a mission of preserving, promoting and enhancing the Appaloosa breed. The ApHC has since registered more than 670,000 Appaloosas, which are known for their distinctive color, intelligence and even temperament. True to their reputation as an extremely versatile breed, Appaloosas can be found in nearly every discipline including racing, endurance riding and serving as a reliable family horse. The international breed registry is headquartered in Moscow, Idaho, the heart of the Palouse region – the Appaloosa breed’s namesake and point of origin.
