Updated for 2011 World Show

Dear Regional Club Pointkeeper or Primary Contact:

Please see the attached forms needed to nominate horses from your regional club for the 2011 World Championship Appaloosa Show.

- (Form A) Outline of World Show Qualifying Requirements - Rule 703
- (Form B) World Show Class list (lists only those classes in which you may submit nominations)
- (Form C) Form on which to list shows that your regional club sponsored, co-sponsored or pointed
- Class Nomination Forms
- World Qualifying Waiver Request Form (*Please continue reading for complete instructions!*)

Please carefully read Form A (Rule 703) regarding regional nominations to the World Show. You must sign the bottom of Form A indicating that you have read and understand the regional qualifying system. **Your signature also indicates that you have complied with Rule 703 in nominating horses for the World Show.**

Please submit a separate class sheet for each class in which you are submitting nominations. You may only submit nominations for those classes listed on Form B. A horse may be nominated only if the owner of that horse is a member of your regional club and you may only nominate horses in classes that were held at your sponsored, pointed or co-pointed shows in the qualifying year from September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011. Forms that lack complete and/or contain inaccurate information will not be accepted.

You may nominate up to 5 horses in each class listed on Form B. Please do not combine junior and senior classes on the nomination forms. For instance, if you held all-ages western riding at your show, separate your junior and senior horses and nominate the junior horses in the junior western riding class and the senior horses in the senior western riding class. This process should be used in all age-appropriate classes including when nominating horses in hunter in hand age-designated classes.

Please submit an updated membership list with your regional club nominations.

If your sponsored, pointed or co-pointed shows were completed prior to August 1, 2011, your nominations, show results and membership lists **must be received in the ApHC office no later than August 15, 2011.** If your sponsored, pointed or co-pointed shows occurred on or after August 1, 2011, your nominations, show results and membership lists **must be received in the ApHC office no later than September 10, 2011. Nominations received after these deadline dates will not be accepted and will not count** toward qualifying horses for the 2011 World Show.

World Qualifying Waiver Request Form

The ApHC will review the point record for each of the top 5 horses in each class as submitted by your club. Those that have earned at least 1 national point will automatically receive an invitation to compete at the World Show. Effective September 1, 2010 and to qualify for the 2011 World Show, an exception may be made to the one (1) National Point requirement if it is documented on forms requested from and provided by the ApHC and submitted to the regional club by the owner of the horse by the World qualifying point cutoff deadline that the horse was entered and attempted in good faith to earn points under at least five (5) different judges in that class during that qualifying year but could not earn the required one (1) point needed for a regional nomination because there were no other entries in that class.

These request forms (as attached), must be completed by the owner or exhibitor of the horse and must be signed by the show secretary or show manager of the shows at which they attempted to compete. They must be submitted to the regional club in advance of the point cut-off deadline. **When you submit your club nominations, include these completed forms with the nomination packet.** Those horses nominated by your club that do not have 1 national point in the class but that DO have the completed waivers attached will receive an invitation to compete at the World Show in the classes in which the properly completed paperwork has been submitted.

Please make sure to include the following items when returning your World Show nominations to the ApHC office:

- Form A - signed to indicate that you have read, understand and complied with the regional qualifying system
- Form B - World Show class list marked to indicate in which classes you are submitting nominations
- Form C - List of shows sponsored, co-sponsored or pointed by your regional club in the point year
- Regional Club class nomination forms (one for each class in which you are submitting a nomination)
- Waiver request forms (at least two completed forms for each horse for each class in which they are nominated)
 - **Please remember that it is the responsibility of the owner and/or exhibitor to provide this completed paperwork to your regional club so that it may be properly submitted with your nomination packet.**
- Updated club membership list

We suggest that you return this information by Federal Express, UPS or other guaranteed mail service or by fax. **Please keep a copy for your records and in case the original doesn't arrive at the ApHC office. It is your responsibility to contact the ApHC office to ensure that they have been received.** Please send to the attention of the Show Department at the address listed below or by fax to 208.882.8150.

703. WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP APPALOOSA SHOW

A. QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS

Under the National Point System, individual owners may qualify horses by meeting the minimum number of point requirements if they are current members in good standing in the ApHC. Those shows which have gained ApHC approval and have met all requirements will count for national points.

1. Under the regional club system, a regional organization officially recognized as an affiliate in good standing with the ApHC may qualify up to five (5) of its top horses for the World Championship Appaloosa Show in each class. In order for a regional club to be eligible to nominate horses for the World Championship Appaloosa Show under the regional qualifying system, that club must have sponsored, pointed or co-sponsored at least one ApHC-approved show in that qualifying year and that regional club may only nominate horses in classes in which such horses exhibited in that club's sponsored, pointed or co-sponsored show.
2. Regional clubs may design their own point system but must meet the following conditions:
 - a. Each show used for regional qualifying points must be an ApHC-approved show. Organizations, clubs or individuals desiring to sponsor or stage shows which will be approved by the ApHC, and which will include the awarding of national points to the top-placing horses entered in the show must obtain approval from the ApHC.
 - b. Owners of horses qualifying under this regional provision must be active members of the regional organization submitting the nomination.
 - c. Horses nominated under the regional club system must earn one national point in the class to be entered, unless the national point qualification for that class is zero.
 - d. A horse may receive only one World Show invitation per class. If it earns an invitation under the National Point System, it becomes ineligible to be nominated by a regional club for that class. **In each class, up to five (5) of the highest-ranking horse from the regional organization not qualifying under the National Point System may receive the invitation.** In the event that all of a regional organization's top five horses qualify under the National Point System, no horse would qualify from that regional club for that class. If a horse qualifies in more than one regional club, it must use whichever qualification shows up first when regional clubs are listed in alphabetical order.
 - e. An exception may be made to the one (1) National Point requirement if it is documented on forms requested from and provided by the ApHC and submitted by the owner of the horse by the World qualifying point cutoff deadline that the horse was entered and attempted in good faith to earn points under at least five (5) different judges in that class during that qualifying year but could not earn the required one (1) point because there were no other entries in that specific class.
3. Point cut-off date for qualifying under both the National Point System and the regional club system is August 31. For shows after that date, the points shall be counted toward the following year. All show results, regional club nominations and current regional club membership lists must be sent by certified mail return receipt or other guaranteed mail service, and must be in the ApHC office by the following deadlines:
 - a. **Shows held prior to August 1 – all results, nominations and membership lists must be received by the ApHC no later than August 15.**
 - b. **Shows held on or after August 1 – all results, nominations and membership lists must be received by the ApHC no later than September 10.**

As Pointkeeper for the above named regional club, I have read and I understand rule 703 and I have complied with rule 703 in nominating horses for the World Show. I also verify that as Pointkeeper for the above named regional club, I have only nominated horses to the World Show that competed in classes that were held at shows that this regional club sponsored, co-sponsored or pointed. I verify that the owner of each horse nominated is a current member of the above named regional club.

Under the regional club qualifying system, a regional club may nominate their top (5) point earning horses in each class to attend the World Show. If the horse has at least one (1) national point in that class, the horse is eligible to earn an invitation to the World Show in that class based upon their nomination by the regional club.

Effective September 1, 2010 and to qualify for the 2011 World Show, an exception may be made to the one (1) National Point requirement if it is documented on forms requested from and provided by the ApHC **and submitted to the regional club by the owner of the horse by the World qualifying point cutoff deadline** that the horse was entered and attempted in good faith to earn points under at least five (5) different judges in that class during that qualifying year but could not earn the required one (1) point needed for a regional nomination because there were no other entries in that class.

At least two of these completed forms must be submitted to the regional club from which the horse will be nominated and must be submitted to the ApHC **by the regional club** along with their World Show nomination packets by the deadline (either August 15 or September 10 – whichever deadline applies to that regional club). See rule 703.A in the *2011 Official Handbook of the Appaloosa Horse Club* for complete rules. *The ApHC will only accept forms from the regional club submitted in conjunction with their nomination packets. These forms will not be accepted directly from the owner or exhibitor of the horse in question.*
