APPALOOSA CROSSES FINISH LINE FIRST AT APPALOOSA/PAINT ALLOWANCE

TULSA, OKLA.—ApHC-registered Appaloosa, D D Marble, dominated the Fair Meadows Race Track in the Appaloosa/Paint Allowance, designated for horses three years and older, in Tulsa, Okla., July 28, 2007.

D D Marble ran the 300-yard dirt track with Mike Frederick aboard, crossing the finish line at 15.698 seconds. The dark bay gelding, owned by Militza Elliot, took home \$5,220 out of the \$9,000 purse. D D Marble is trained by Hubert Blankenship. Bred by G and G Partnership, D D Marble is by My Designated Driver and out of All the Marbles.

Bootlegger Moon (APHA) followed D D Marble in second place, finished in 15.823 seconds. The 3-year-old Paint colt, owned by Joe and Kathy Judkins, drew off under Adam Roughley, winning \$1,740. Bootlegger Moon is trained by James Limbaugh.

Third place winner was Flashes Quick Girl, ridden by Debbie Freeman. The 3-year-old Paint filly finished the 300-yard race in 15.857 seconds, winning \$957. Flashes Quick Girl is owned and trained by Wayne Kendrick.

Other horses completing the field include—Read My Lips (APHA), Such a Ladys Man (APHA), Cash Creek (APHA), Rosy Dial (APHA), Braggin Rights (ApHC), Bully Boy Flash (APHA) and Tma Moonshine (ApHC).
