## Competitive Trail Ride Notes

- A Competitive Trail Ride is defined as a ride where participants cover a marked course in a given period of time; no less than 25 miles in one day or 30 miles (50 to count for medallion) in two; and is required to have a licensed veterinarian present for monitoring and judging. A separate merit system is in place for events such as Mountain Horse Challenges, Trail Trials, Trail Challenges and similar competitions under the Judged Trail Ride category of the Appaloosa Competitive all-Breed Activities Program (ACAAP).
- A rider, if different than a current registered owner, must also be a current ApHC member in order for mileage to count.
- The horse must receive a completion in order for the mileage to count.
- ApHC Ride Year runs from December 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>. Any rides occurring after November 30<sup>th</sup> will be recorded on the horse's record for the *following* ride year.
- It is requested that Ride Reports are submitted within 10 days after completion of a ride in order to track current status of Year-End Award mileage. Absolute deadline is Dec 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Competitive Trail Rides 25 miles in length or more will be applied to the annual medallion, annual high mileage awards, 1000-mile award, 500-mile SEA and 250-mile ROM.
- Competitive rides of less than 25 miles in length and novice rides will be recorded on the horse's performance record but will not count toward any awards.
- Double bonus mileage will be awarded to a horse receiving High Point ("Sweepstakes") at a given competitive trail ride; to be applied to the 350-mi medallion only. This is for the *overall* ride High Point, not for any subdivision of age, weight or ApHC-registered competitors.
