APPALOOSA WINS BIG AT SPOTS N DOTS STAKES

TULSA, OKLA.—Friday the 13th may prove unlucky for some, but not so for Appaloosa, Im A Marble To. The gelding dominated the competition in the Spots N Dots Stakes, restricted to 3 years and older Appaloosas and Paints, at Fair Meadows race track in Tulsa, Okla., winning first place by one length.

Im A Marble To drew off under Adam Wade Roughley, and proved luck does not apply by completing the 870-yard race in 46.34 seconds earning \$16,320 of the \$27,500 purse. The 9-year-old Appaloosa, owned by G&G Partnership/Geier, is trained by Hubert Blankenship.

Paul Nieto rode Boy of Summer, a 6-year-old Paint, to second, earning \$5,440. The gelding is trained by Tim Weeder.

Jay James rode Appaloosa gelding, Zevis Kidd, to complete the race in third, taking home \$2,992. The 4-year-old is owned by Nicholas Schramm and trained by Raymond Venn.

Horse completing the field, including—Suzys Hero (APHA), Lone Star Rising (ApHC), DD Marble, Roman Guard (APHA), Special Judy (APHA), Earth Wind and Fire (APHA) and Braggin Rights (ApHC).
