APPALOOSA DOMINATES PAINTS AT THE TRACK

HOUSTON, TEXAS.—ApHC-registered gelding, Cmb a Legacy, flew past a handful of Paint horses to claim the first place win at the Gulf Cost Derby, valued at \$6,825, in Houston, Texas, Aug. 3.

The 3-year-old Appaloosa drew off under Rodrigo Vallejo, completing the 350-yard race in 18.030 seconds. Cmb a Legacy, owned by Cmb Don Keys Racing Stables, won \$4,500 for his first place win. Bred by Bosen Land & Livesock, the chestnut gelding is by Geneo Jj and out of Key Legacy. Cmb a Legacy is trained by Judd Kearnl.

Finishing in second, Beyond the Dream (APHA), was no match for Cmb a Legacy. The 3-year-old Paint mare, ridden by Melody Brooks, finished the race in 19.171 seconds, taking home \$1,500. Beyond the Dream is owned by Jose Guzman and trained by Fidencio Maldonado.

Tricks Van Tyke (APHA), with Mark Kidder aboard, finished the race in 19.367 seconds, receiving \$825. The 3-year-old Paint colt is owned by Gary and Catherine Gann and trained by Gary Gann.

The final horse completing the field was Dominant Attitude (APHA).
