MOON BULLY DUELED ALL OUT FOR THE WIN IN THE COWBOY HALL OF FAME HANDICAP

MOSCOW, Idaho— **Moon Bully**, a 2004 appaloosa gelding, dueled all out to win the Cowboy Hall of Fame Handicap at Remington Park, in Oklahoma City, Okla., on May 21, 2011.

Moon Bully bred by John Holley of Mount Juliet, Tenn., owned by Dub Seely of Grandview, Texas was jockeyed by Stormy Smith. **Moon Bully** ran the 440-yard race in 21.987 seconds holding APHA Barney Ofied to second place finish with a time of 21.989. **Moon Bully** is by **Man With The Power (ApHC)** and out of **TB Fancy Moon (AQHA)**. **Moon Bully's** career earnings are \$191,698.00 after bringing home the first place check for \$18,000 at Remington Park on May 23, 2011. The Appaloosa Race Champion began his race career in 2006 with 9 starts, 2 wins, 2 places and 1 show and first year earnings totaling \$22,776. Fast forward to today and his lifetime career includes 57 starts, 17 wins, 8 shows and 12 places. Moon Bully has amassed 5 ApHC Bronze Racing Medallions and has earned many top honors including: 2010, 2009 and 2008 Race Supreme Champion, 2008 Champion Claiming Horse.

The following horses completed the race in this order: Barney Ofied (APHA) 21.989, Special Sign (APHA) 22.019, Blast the Cash (APHA)22.060, Cutrock (APHA) 22.094, Dodacious (APHA) 22.275, Flashy Dos (APHA) 22.399, Ww Granite Treasure (APHA) 22.479, I Do One Two Three (APHA) 22.574
