APPALOOSAS DOMINATE IN BLACKFOOT

BLACKFOOT, Idaho— Appaloosas dominated the race track at the Eastern Idaho State Fair in Black Foot Idaho Sept. 5 claiming the top two slots in a 350-yard Two-Year-Old futurity race.

Appaloosa mare, **Let Er Rip**, owned by Janyce Paulsen of Pocatello, ID claimed first place in the exhilarating race. **Let Er Rip**, jockeyed by Dallas Erickson completed the race in 18.490, followed by Appaloosa stallion, **A Time For Cash**. Following **A Time For Cash** and claiming the third place was APHA Running Paint Horse, Gray Horse Lass.

Let Er Rip was sired by ApHC stallion, Taken The Cash and ApHC mare, Angel On A High. **A Time For Cash**, jockeyed by Wes Smith, also boasted an impressive time, finishing the race in 18.580. **A Time For Cash** was Bred by Boxen Land & Livestock of Preston, ID, and is currently owned by Glen T. Jamison & Delray Talbot of Preston, ID.
