MS TEXAS ROYAL SNOW BREAKS MAIDEN

MOSCOW, Idaho— Appaloosa **Ms Texas Royal Snow** drives for the win in Race 1, on April 17, 2015. The 350-yard maiden claiming race for three-year-olds and upward was held at Remington Park in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma with a field of ten, of which two were Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$9,600. Claiming price was \$5,000.

Ms Texas Royal Snow (This Snow Is Royal, AQHA x Texas Union by Moon Lark, AQHA) a 3-year-old mare, had a driving finish under jockey David Pinon to cross the finish line in 18.049 seconds, earning a 74 speed index. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa won \$5,340 for her efforts bringing her lifetime earnings to \$8,968. The mare is currently owned by Jimmy Maddux of Texas and was bred by Jimmy Maddux of Texas and is trained by Mollie Devereaux.

Oh Doux Win (Easy Doux, AQHA x Oh Lily Win by Will Win, JC) a 3-year-old mare, also finished the race.
