## LEAVING ME SPOTTED BREAKS MAIDEN IN TULSA

**MOSCOW, Idaho**— Appaloosa **Leaving Me Spotted** edged away for the win in race 7 at the summer meet in Oklahoma. The 250-yard maiden claiming race was for three-year-olds and older. The race was held at Fair Meadows in Tulsa, Oklahoma on July 12, 2015. It had a field of six, of which two were Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$4,740. The claiming price was set at \$5,000.

**Leaving Me Spotted** (**Leaving Memories**, AQHA x **Omega Bull** by **Mr Spotted Bull**) a 3-year-old filly, had a driving finish under jockey David Hunt, to cross the finish line in 13.736 seconds, earning a 73 speed index. The Kansas-bred Appaloosa won \$2,646 for her efforts and brought her lifetime earnings to \$6,631. This filly is currently owned and bred by Jodee Rowe of Kansas and is trained by Gregg Sanders.

**Zoomin JJ** (**Geneo JJ** x **Zoomin From The Bar** by **Shazoom**, AQHA) a 3-year-old filly finished fourth under jockey Andrew Samaniego. The filly is owned and bred by Bruce Miller and trained by Frank Cooper.
