## TEXAS CARTEL BREAKS MAIDEN IN OKLAHOMA

**MOSCOW, Idaho**— Appaloosa **Texas Cartel** gave his best for the win in race 8 at the summer meet in Oklahoma. The 350-yard maiden claiming race was for two-year-olds. The race was held at Fair Meadows in Tulsa, Oklahoma on July 16, 2015. It had a field of eight, of which only one was Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$4,900. The claiming value was \$5,000.

**Texas Cartel** (**Cartel Success**, AQHA x **Texas Union** by **Moon Lark**, AQHA) a 2-year-old gelding, had a winning finish under jockey Agustin Silva, to cross the finish line in 18.499 seconds, earning a 64 speed index. The Texas-bred Appaloosa won \$2,538 for his efforts and brought his lifetime earnings to \$3,914. This gelding is currently owned and bred by Jimmy Maddux of Texas and is trained by Mollie Devereaux.
