SHOW ME YOUR GLORY CAN'T BE DENIED IN WYOMING

MOSCOW, Idaho— Appaloosa **Show Me Your Glory** blew past the competition for the win in race 1 down in Wyoming. The 400-yard trial race was for the Wyoming Downs Derby set to run August 8th. The race was held at Wyoming Downs in Evanston, Wyoming on July 25, 2015. It had a field of eight, of which one was Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$3,000.

Show Me Your Glory (With Honors, AQHA x Miss Fancy Layne by R Limited Edition) a 3-year-old gelding, couldn't be denied the win under jockey Cody House, to cross the finish line in 19.898 seconds, earning an 102 speed index. The Utah-bred Appaloosa won \$1,800 for his efforts and brought his lifetime earnings to \$11,365. This gelding is currently owned and was bred by Chris Brandon of Utah and is trained by Woody Green.
