TEN BUNNY GAME WINNER AT CLAREMORE

MOSCOW, Idaho— Appaloosa **Ten Bunny** was first across the line in race 1 at the fall meet in Oklahoma. The 300-yard maiden race was for two-year-olds. The race was held at Will Rogers Downs in Claremore, Oklahoma on October 17, 2015. It had a mixed field of six, of which two were Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$7,680.

Ten Bunny (Ten Streaks, AQHA x The Energizer Bunny by Zevis Scooter Bug) a 2-year-old gelding, had a winning finish under jockey Randy Wilson, to cross the finish line in 15.886 seconds, earning an 80 speed index. The Kansas-bred Appaloosa won \$4,446 for his efforts and brought his lifetime earnings to \$6,093. This gelding is currently owned and bred by Jeff Rutland of Kansas and is trained by Jeff Rutland.

Doux Hickey (Easy Doux, AQHA x Dashing Cleata by Dashing Cleat, AQHA) a 2-year-old filly, finished fourth. This filly is proudly owned by Linda Taylor of Oklahoma.
