CATCHA CORONA IFUCAN VICTORIOUS

MOSCOW, Idaho— Appaloosa **Catcha Corona Ifucan** was game winner in Race 3, on October 18, 2015. The 300-yard claiming race for three-year-olds and upward that haven't won two, was held at Will Rogers Downs in Claremore, Oklahoma with a mixed field of seven, of which two were Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$4,140. Claiming price was \$5,000.

Catcha Corona Ifucan (Corona Top Cat, AQHA x Catch If Catch Can by Heza Fast Man, AQHA) a 3-year-old gelding, had a solid finish under jockey Jesus Salazar to cross the finish line in 15.726 seconds, earning a 85 speed index. The Texas-bred Appaloosa won \$2,292 for his efforts bringing his lifetime earnings to \$10,136. The gelding is currently owned by Garrett Baker of Oklahoma and was bred by Glen Wilkerson of Texas and is trained by Donnie Strickland.

Ms Texas Royal Snow (This Snow Is Royal, AQHA x Texas Union by Moon Lark, AQHA) a 3-year-old mare, finished fourth. This mare is owned by Jimmy Maddox of Texas.
