APPSOLUTELY T SPRINTS TO THE WINNERS CIRCLE

MOSCOW, Idaho— Appaloosa **Appsolutely T** was first across the line in race 2.. The 250-yard maiden race was for two-year-olds. The race was held at Will Rogers Downs in Claremore, Oklahoma on October 24, 2015. It had a mixed field of five, of which two were Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$7,980.

Appsolutely T (Freighttrain B, AQHA x Special Six Moons by Special Task, AQHA) a 2-year-old gelding, had a winning finish under jockey William Thomason, to cross the finish line in 13.843 seconds, earning a 71 speed index. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa won \$4,800 for his efforts and brought his lifetime earnings to \$16,716. This gelding is currently owned and bred by Jeffrey Tyree of Oklahoma and is trained by Jeffery Tyree.

Sinful Ways (Country Chicks Man, AQHA x R Girls Night Out by Corona Cartel, AQHA) a 2-year-old filly, had a dueling second place finish under jockey Randy Wilson, to cross the finish line in 13.902 seconds, earning a 69 speed index. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa won \$1,680 for her first ever start. This filly is currently owned and bred by Jeff Adams of Oklahoma and is trained by Dee Keener.
