CMB DIXIE FIXX Puts ON THE SPEED IN OKLAHOMA

MOSCOW, Idaho—3-year-old appaloosa gelding CMB Dixie Fixx won handily at Remington Park in Oklahoma City, Okla., on April 23, 2011 in the 330-year Claiming race for 3-year-olds and up.

CMB Dixie Fixx proudly owned by Jose Arroyo of Tulsa, Okla. and ridden by Ricky Ramirez, took the race in 16.815 seconds narrowly missing the track record of 16.384 seconds set by Jess Special Candy (APHA) on March 13, 2011. This winning appaloosa bred by Christopher Brandon of Farr West, Utah took home \$3,930 of the total purse valued at \$7,340 bringing his lifetime earning total to \$18,533.

The following horses completed the race in this order: Wendys A Lil Country (APHA), Dashing Susie (ApHC), Country Quick Treasure (APHA), TJ Streaker (APHA), Gambles Lake (APHA), Willy Awesome (APHA), Sutherland (APHA), Mucho Suarte (APHA) and Spittin Kid (ApHC).
