STREAKIN PRINCE TAKES HIS FIRST WIN IN MAIDEN RACE

CLAREMORE, Okla.—Appaloosa Streakin Prince had the fastest legs Apr. 27 in a 330-yard maiden race for 3-year-olds and up at Will Rogers Downs in Claremore, Okla. The purse was valued at \$8,500.

Streakin Prince, a 3-year-old gelding, made a driving finish with Adam Roughley aboard to cross the finish line in 17.605 seconds. The Pennsylvania-bred Appaloosa won \$4,920 and brought his lifetime earnings to \$10,894. Streakin Prince (Streak And Dash, AQHA x Princess Oh) is proudly owned and was bred by Fred R. Stonesifer of Everett, Pa., and is trained by James Limbaugh.

Appaloosa **Mr Bulls Eye** (Eye To Eye x Bulls Bar Maid Kate) finished the race third after Paint horse Catch This Kitty claimed second place. The 3-year-old Appaloosa colt crossed the finish line under Mike Frederick in 17.820 seconds to win \$902 and brought his lifetime earnings to \$1,022. Mr Bulls Eye is proudly owned and was bred by Cecil Newberry of Green Forest, Ark., and is trained by Jeff Tyer.

The following horses completed the race in this order: Eyesa Huckleberry (APHA), Mr Hot Country (APHA), Midnight Deposit (ApHC), Coronas Jess Easy (ApHC), Princess Friona (APHA), Special Liniment (APHA) and Nedstenaciousdiamond (ApHC).
