APPALOOSAS TAKE OVER REMINGTON PARK

Oklahoma City, Okla.—Appaloosa “Flying T Rudy” takes win in all-Appaloosa race on the track May 31 in the 300-yard Allowance race at Remington Park in Oklahoma City, Okla. The race was valued at \$18,400.

Flying T Rudy, a 2-year-old colt, had his first win with Tony Bennett astride to claim first place in 15.848 seconds. The Idaho-bred Appaloosa won \$10,338. Flying T Rudy (With Honors AQHA x Flying T Love) is owned by Danny and Shauna Thomas of Roy, Utah, trained by Dee Keener and bred by Kent and Judy Taylor of Blackfoot, Idaho.

Other horses in the race included: Allies Apollo (ApHC), Velvet Cowgirl (ApHC), Look Here Boys (ApHC), Ima Fast Man (ApHC), Patricks memories (ApHC), CD Eyeza Hoss (ApHC), and Justice B Kas (ApHC).
