“D D MARBLE” ROLLS INTO LEAD

Tulsa, Okla.—Appaloosa “D D Marble” dueled with “Suchanattitidue”^{APHA} and “Socoolsheshot”^{ApHC} on the track June 27 in the 350-yard claiming race at Fair Meadows in Tulsa, Okla. The race was valued at \$4,500.

D D Marble, a 7-year-old gelding, made an impressive win with Adam Roughley aboard claiming first place, by a neck, in 13.416 seconds. The Kansas-bred Appaloosa won \$2,430 and brought his lifetime earnings to \$40,605. While earning a speed index of 91 in this race, D D Marble (My Designated Driver x All The Marbles) was owned by Elliot Militza of Sallisaw Okla., but was claimed for \$4,000. He was bred by G and G Partnership of Girard, KS, and trained by Hubert Blankenship.

Socoolsheshot, a 3-year-old mare, dueled all the way and fought gamely. Losing by a nose, Socoolsheshot gave way grudgingly for third place, but earned a speed index of 90. She was owned and bred by Dr. John V. White DVM, but claimed in the race for \$4,000. She was trained by Mike Taylor.

Other horses in the race include: TJ Chrome (APHA), Kiss This Chrome (APHA), Uh Huh Judy (APHA), Special Blast (APHA), Open Range (ApHC), Johnnycantcatchme (APHA), and Suzys Hero (APHA).

Appaloosa Racing

Appaloosas have long been an integral part of one of America’s most popular spectator sports—horse racing. The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) officially recognized the sport in 1962, beginning Appaloosa racing history with four races and 23 starters competing for \$12,000 in total purses. In 2009, 157 Appaloosas competed in 305 races for \$2.7 million in total purses.
