FAIR MEADOWS BECOMES “NOTCHSONTHEBEDPOST”

Tulsa, Okla.—Appaloosa “Notchsonthebedpost” remains unbeaten in 2010! On June 17th, she went wire to wire with Royal Quick Shine_{APHA}. As one of two Appaloosas in a 300-yard allowance race, Notchsonthebedpost convincingly took the lead to win by an entire length at Fair Meadows in Tulsa, Okla. The race was valued at \$9,350.

Notchsonthebedpost, a 4-year-old mare, finishing ahead with the comments “too tuff” ringing out after her hoof beats ended. She had Randy Wilson aboard to claim first place in 15.602 seconds, earning a speed index of 95. This Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa won \$5,255 and brought her lifetime earnings to \$18,059. Notchsonthebedpost (Eye To Eye x Shift) is owned and trained by Keith Dooly of El Reno, Okla., and was bred by Gary Walker of El Reno, Okla..

Appaloosas have long been an integral part of one of America’s most popular spectator sports—horse racing. The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) officially recognized the sport in 1962, beginning Appaloosa racing history with four races and 23 starters competing for \$12,000 in total purses. In 2009, 157 Appaloosas competed in 305 races for \$2.7 million in total purses.
