## APPALOOSAS MAKE BIG RACE WINS AT POCATELLO DOWNS

**POCATELLO, Idaho**—Appaloosas made a colorful impression at Pocatello Downs in the end of May. Appaloosas Camptown Kelly and Socoolsheshot both earned blue ribbons at the Pocatello, Idaho, racetrack on May 30.

Camptown Kelly competed in a 350-yard derby, which offered a \$4,000 purse.

Camptown Kelly (Darkelly, AQHA x Camptownhigh) edged out the competition to take the win and complete the track in 18.545 seconds. The 3-year-old colt won \$2,400, and has earned \$10,998 in his lifetime. Camptown Kelly is proudly owned by Delra Talbot and Glen Jamison of Preston, Idaho, is trained by T. Hyde and was bred by Bosen Land & Livestock.

Appaloosa Tisa Dandy Appy Andy (The Royal Jester x Josh N Johnny) followed in second and crossed the finish line in 18.584 seconds. The 3-year-old gelding won \$1,000, and has lifetime total of \$6,710. Tisa Dandy Appy Andy is proudly owned by Andy and Mary Atkinson of Pocatello, Idaho, is trained by R.P. Smith and was bred by Bosen Land & Livestock.

Completing the run was Appaloosa TANDB Top Honors (With Honors, AQHA x J&B Top Banana). The 3-year-old filly finished the race in 18.697 seconds to win \$600, which brought her lifetime earnings to \$781.

Other horses who completed the field include Rock N Roll Ruby (ApHC), Just What I Do (ApHC), Kories Silk (APHA), Anna Dial Effort (APHA) and Proudest Gamble (APHA).

Socoolsheshot competed to win a 330-yard futurity with a purse of \$11,000 scheduled later that same day.

Socoolsheshot (Hotdoggin, AQHA x Shes Cool) earned first place after she crossed the finish line in 17.302 seconds. The 2-year-old filly won \$4,400 and has earned \$4,700 in her lifetime. Socoolsheshot is proudly owned and was bred by Dr. and Mrs. John V. White Jr. of Fort Collins, Colo., and is trained by Mike Taylor.

Calico Empress (APHA) followed in second and completed the track in 17.623 seconds. The 2-year-old filly won \$2,090.

Appaloosa Audaciously (Hotdoggin, AQHA x Won A Queen) rounded out the top three after she completed the track in 17.770 seconds. The 2-year-old filly won \$1,320 for a lifetime total of \$8,739. Audaciously is proudly owned and was bred by John V. White Jr., DVM, of Fort Collins, Colo., and is trained by John McBride.

Other horses who completed the field included Two Fuzz One (APHA), Sw Tinker Too (APHA), CMB A Royal Legacy (ApHC), Maples Wrangler (ApHC), My Lil Idaho Tornado (ApHC) and Gke Go Rocky Go (ApHC).

### Appaloosa Racing

Appaloosas have long been an integral part of one of America's most popular spectator sports—horse racing. The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) officially recognized the sport in 1962, beginning Appaloosa racing history with four races and 23 starters competing for \$12,000 in total purses. In 2008, 186 Appaloosas competed in 399 races for \$3.1 million in total purses.
