APPALOOSA DEMANDS LEAD

Tulsa, Okla.—Appaloosa “G I Jana” dueled with “TH Agouti”^{APHA} and wouldn’t be denied on the track July 22 in the 250-yard allowance race at Fair Meadows in Tulsa, Okla. TH Agouti made a big effort, but was outnodded in the end. The race was valued at \$10,500.

G I Jana, a 5-year-old mare, made an impressive win with Adalberto Candanosa aboard claiming first place, by a head, in 13.152 seconds. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa won \$6,092 and brought her lifetime earnings to \$95,841. Earning a speed index of 103 in this race, G I Jana (Brisco County Jr^{AQHA} X Sure Nuff Fast) is owned by Jana Harrison of Stonewall, Okla. She was bred by Ronald D. Fowler of Chanute, Kan., and is trained by Luis Villafranco.

Other horses in the race include: Sassy Man^{APHA}, Make No Shadows^{APHA}, Texas Royal Snow^{ApHC}, Quick Hombre^{APHA}, La Pecos^{APHA}.

Appaloosa Racing

Appaloosas have long been an integral part of one of America’s most popular spectator sports—horse racing. The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) officially recognized the sport in 1962, beginning Appaloosa racing history with four races and 23 starters competing for \$12,000 in total purses. In 2009, 157 Appaloosas competed in 305 races for \$2.7 million in total purses.
