APPALOOSAS RUN FOR FUTURITY TRIAL WIN

SALLISAW, OKLA.—Ten Appaloosas fought for a first place win in a futurity trial race Oct. 6 at Blue Ribbon Downs in Sallisaw, Okla. The 2-year-old Appaloosas ran the 330-yard track for a piece of the \$1,500 purse.

Appaloosa, G I Jana, claimed the first place win. The 2-year-old filly, ridden by Larry Payne, completed the track in 16.972 seconds. She won \$750, bringing her lifetime earnings to \$4,266. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa is by Brisco County Jr and out of Sure Nuff Fast. G I Jana is owned by Jana Harrison; trained by Eddie Willis; and was bred by Ronald D. Fowler.

Appaloosa, A Day Before, crossed the finish line in 16.981 seconds. With Adam Roughley aboard, the 2-year-old gelding won \$450, bringing his lifetime earnings to \$14,658. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa is by Dispensing Speed and out of It's Cash's Perks. A Before is owned and trained by James Limbaugh.

Appaloosa, Blue Oyster Cult, made a strong finish in third. The 2-year-old colt, ridden by Adalberto Candanosa, finished the race in 17.058 seconds. He won \$300, bringing his lifetime earnings to \$13,783. The Wyoming-bred colt is by Royal Shake Em (AQHA) and out of Tis A Little Food. Blue Oyster Cult is owned by John McBride, and trained by Dee Keener.

Appaloosa Racing

Appaloosas have long been an integral part of one of America's most popular spectator sports—horse racing. The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) officially recognized the sport in 1962, beginning Appaloosa racing history with four races and 23 starters competing for \$12,000 in total purses. In 2006, 203 starters competed in 440 races for \$2,904,774 in total purses.

Racing fans can find Appaloosas crossing the finish line in Arizona, California, Colorado, Kansas, Michigan, Montana, Nevada, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, Washington and Wyoming.
