SINFUL WAYS WINS AT REMINGTON PARK

MOSCOW, Idaho— Appaloosa **Sinful Ways** prevailed for the win in race 1 at the spring meet in Oklahoma City, OK. The 330-yard maiden claiming race for three, four and five-year-olds was held at Remington Park in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. It had a field of eight, of which two were Appaloosa. The purse was valued at \$10,100. Claiming price was \$12,500.

Sinful Ways (R Girls Night Out, ApHC by Country Chicks Man, AQHA) a 3-year-old chestnut mare, had a solid finish under jockey Randy Wilson, to cross the finish line in 17.086 seconds, earning a 69 speed index. The Oklahoma-bred Appaloosa won \$6,648 for her efforts bringing her lifetime earnings to \$8,767. The mare is currently owned and was bred and trained by Jeff Adams of Oklahoma.

Explosive Deer Bug (Joe G., JC x First Rose by First Installment, AQHA) a 4-year-old chestnut colt also finished the race. He is owned and trained by Albert Wright of Oklahoma.
