## **NOMINATION PERIOD EXTENDED FOR 2016 ApHC BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION**

**MOSCOW, Idaho**— The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) has extended the nomination period for Declarations of Candidacy for the 2016 ApHC Board of Directors Election from July 31, 2016 to **August 31, 2016**. This change is the direct result of Board Motion 01-08-16 that passed unanimously at the August 4, 2016 ApHC Board of Directors Conference Call.

This motion is the product of a clerical error.
