

# Construction/Traffic Update – Will Rogers Memorial Center

Construction of the new Dickies Arena is under way and the new 2,200-space garage is nearing completion to its south. The City of Fort Worth is also about to start a renovation of Montgomery Street in preparation for the arena opening in late 2019. Starting in mid-June, work will begin on a portion of the northbound lanes and continue with other portions of the street until mid-2019 as detailed below.

**Phase One - Northbound:** From mid-June 2017 to early January 2018, the northbound lanes of Montgomery Street from just north of Trail Drive to Camp Bowie Boulevard will be closed for renovation. Two-way traffic will be maintained in the southbound lanes. Event attendees traveling on Montgomery Street will have access to the WRMC campus via Trail Drive; however, University Drive would be the recommended route from I-30 because of anticipated congestion on Montgomery Street.

## Conceptual Phasing Plan

Limits of Phase 1 and Phase 2 will vary from the Traffic Control Plans in order to maximize the amount of work completed prior to the Stock Show Moratorium in 2018 and 2019. Paving within any phase must be complete to allow for two lanes of traffic in each direction for the Stock Show(s) periods.
