It is the sole responsibility of the owner to complete this form, obtain the ride manager's signature and submit it to the ApHC office for miles to be entered into the horse's record. While reports are requested within 30 days of the ride, they must be submitted no later than Dec 15 following the end of the current ride year (Nov 30). Ride results received after that date will not be accepted or recorded. Mileages and participation will be verified with the sanctioning organization(s).

Competitive Trail Ride Notes

A Competitive Trail Ride is defined as a ride where participants cover a marked course in a given period of time - no less than 25 miles in one day or 50 miles in two to count toward a medallion. The ride is required to have a licensed veterinarian present for monitoring and judging.

- **The horse must be enrolled in the distance program to earn miles – one-time fee of \$35/horse.** After the first year, there is an annual \$10 fee to have results recorded in the horse's record. This fee should be submitted with the first ride report sent in for the current ride year.
- Both the current recorded owner of the horse and the rider (if different than the owner) must be current ApHC members for mileage to count.
- The horse must receive a completion for mileage to count.
- ApHC Ride Year is December 1 – November 30.
- Ride results must be received by the ApHC within 30 days of the ride in order to track current status of Year-End Award mileage. Absolute deadline is Dec 15.
- Competitive Trail Rides 25 miles/day in length or more will be applied toward the annual medallion, annual high mileage awards, 1000-mile award, 500-mile SEA and 250-mile ROM.
- Competitive rides of less than 25 miles/day in length and novice rides will be recorded on the horse's performance record but will not count toward any awards.
- Double bonus mileage will be awarded to a horse receiving High Point ("Sweepstakes") at a given competitive trail ride; to be applied to the 350-mile medallion only. This is for the *overall* ride High Point, not for any subdivision of age, weight or ApHC-registered competitors.
- There is a late fee of \$75/year to correct mileage records from prior years. Mileage added after the completion of the ride year shall not affect any annual or year-end awards earned within that ride year.
